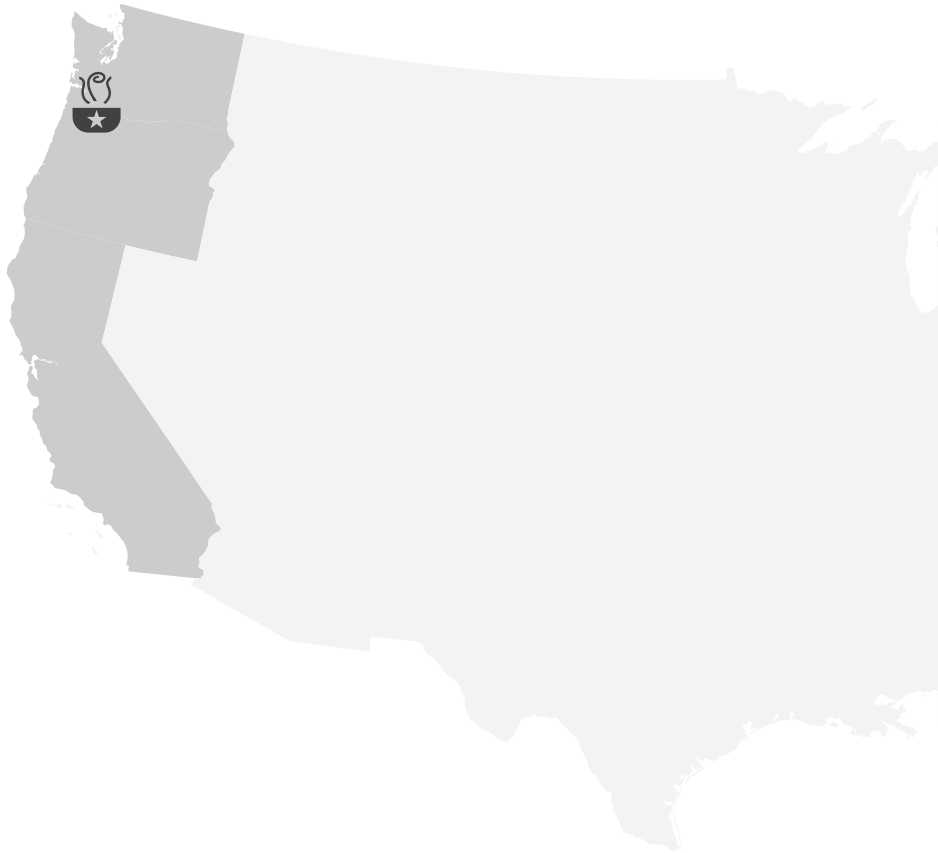

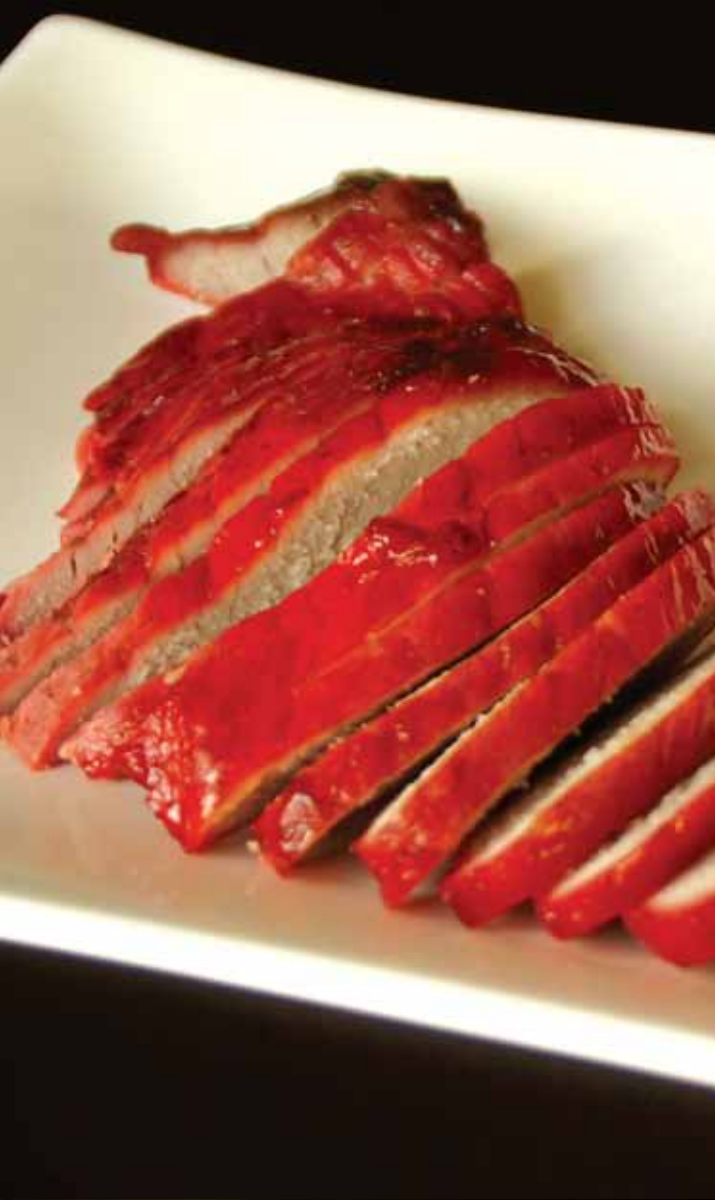

Cook until well done then add rice, noodles and / or vegetables. To cook raw BBQ pork, heat in a conventional oven: 400°, 40 minutes, turn after 10 - 15 minutes until cooked through.

Cooking Instructions

Fried: Heat a small amount of oil in wok or deep fryer over medium-high heat. When the oil is hot, drop in wontons and deep-fry until light golden brown. It will take approximately 1 minute to fry each batch. Drain oil from fried wontons on paper towels.

Boiled: Add wontons to large pot of boiling water; cook until filling is no longer pink, about 5 minutes (7 minutes if frozen); drain.

rice noodles

Cooking Instructions

Cut two pounds of rice noodles into three-quarter inch width strips, heat a wok or frying pan until hot. Add one and a half tablespoons of oil and one teaspoon of garlic, gently stir for 10 seconds. Add rice noodles, stir and toss until hot. Add a tablespoon of soy sauce and a teaspoon of oyster sauce, stir and toss for one minute. Add a one-eighth cup of green onions (cut in one inch long segments) and a cup of bean sprouts, stir and toss until hot and well combined. Serve fresh.

Cooking Instructions

Bring water to a boil and cook noodles until they're cooked through, but still firm. Remove noodles, rinse under cold water and drain. For Yakisoba noodles, skip preceding instructions. Toss noodles about to prevent them from sticking together, then fry them, or add them to your stir-fry or soup.
